1. Outline and purpose of the event

Malaysia-Japan International Institute of Technology (MJIT) was established in Kuala Lumpur in 2011 as an academic institution of Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) based on the agreement of the governments of Japan and Malaysia. With the support of the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), we are promoting joint degree programs and academic exchanges in collaboration with the Japanese University Consortium, which is formed from 30 Japanese universities and institutions. Additionally, in industry-academia collaboration, we are working to promote collaboration with Japanese industry, such as internships and joint / contract research.
